

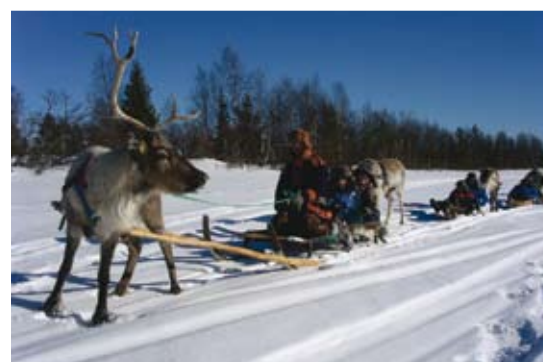


Winter week in Swedish Lapland Forest Hotel -Lapland Wilderness Lodge

- Day 1 On your arrival at Forest Hotel, we welcome you with a culinary forest drink in the lavvu tepee. You can get to know our hotel, relax and perhaps have something in the bar or in front of the open fireplace. This is followed by a 2-course dinner. Information about your stay is handed out, along with warm winter clothing.
- Day 2 Guided tour of Tärendö Village. We visit one of the best-preserved folklore centres in Lapland, beautifully situated beside the Tärendö River. We also see the church, and the guide shows us around the northernmost sawmill in Scandinavia. Lunch is served in Forest Hotel. After lunch, a lesson in the basics of cross-country skiing, which will prove useful for the rest of the week.
- Day 3 A whole-day snowmobile tour, offering beautiful forest scenery and open spaces. The guides prepare lunch over an open fire.
- Day 4 A half-hour journey for a day at Husky Farm, including ice-fishing. You get to drive a dogsled yourself, with eager sleddogs towing you through forest landscape. We enjoy a tasty wild-country lunch.
- Day 5 Free day. You have a choice of activities: a snowmobile tour, dogsledding or why not a visit to the world-famous ICEHOTEL in Jukkasjärvi?
- Day 6 Visit to Sami Peter Perttu and his reindeer. A taste of Sami culture and an insight into the Sami (Lappish) lifestyle. You can also try lassoing and driving a reindeer sleigh. In the lavvu, you can taste different delicacies and Peter will prepare a Sami lunch.
- Day 7 Free Day. You have a choice of activities: a snowmobile tour, dogsledding or perhaps a visit to the world-famous ICEHOTEL in Jukkasjärvi. Time to return the winter clothing. We round off the week with a 3-course dinner and the Arctic Circle Ceremony.
- Day 8 Departure for the airport.

Each day includes breakfast and a well-prepared 2-course dinner. Naturally, the sauna is heated every evening for those who want it. You can also try our wood-fired bathtub under a starry sky. Cross-country skiing equipment, snowshoes and ice-fishing gear may be borrowed all week by whoever wants them.
