



Summer in Swedish Lapland Jockfall

- Day 1** You are met at the airport for transfer to Jockfall and accommodation in cabins. You then get to know the surroundings and after dinner we tell you about the fishing at Jockfall and on Ängesån. We also tell you how a salmon ladder works and everything else you need to know for your stay with us.
- Day 2** After breakfast, at nine, the guide takes you on your first fishing tour. We start by fishing closest to the falls and continue during the day fishing gradually moving down the river. The area below the falls consists of two large basins, where the salmon rest to gather strength to continue up the river system. We then eat lunch in the campground restaurant. The fishing continues the rest of the day and our guide points out the best spots. After the day's fishing, time for a sauna and a delicious dinner in the restaurant.
- Day 3** Today the goal is Ängesån, known as the "fly-fishers' river". The guide takes you along to the best salmon fishing spots on this beautiful river. Both lunch and dinner are enjoyed outdoors by the river and we return to Jockfall in the early hours.
- Day 4** Today we try our hand at trolling fishing at Ansvär, 5 km downstream from Jockfall. We fish from boats on the flatwater stretches between rapids. During the day, we will be fishing both from boats and land. The area is highly suitable for both spinner and fly-fishing. With luck, you will also come up against well-fed graylings or trout. We have lunch at a windbreak with grill fire, while admiring the beautiful riverside landscape. Dinner is in the campground restaurant.
- Day 5-7** The days are earmarked for independent fishing tours in the area. You yourself decide where to fish. Lunch and dinner in the restaurant or you take along a food pack.
- Day 8** After breakfast, this fishing holiday ends and it is time to depart for the airport. You are richer in memories and experiences of the glistening Kalix River salmon and its magnificent setting. We hope you have enjoyed your stay at Jockfall, and perhaps learned a thing or two at the same time.

Each morning before we set off on a fishing tour, we assemble for a brief run-through. We look over the equipment and the flies to make sure that everything is in order for the day's fishing.

Jockfall

Jockfall fishing and recreation facility is in a beautiful setting on the River Kalix at Jockfall in Överkalix District. In addition to the powerful River Kalix, the place has a major attraction in the mighty waterfall with a drop of 9 metres. Jockfall is the pearl of the River Kalix, known for its excellent fishing and spectacular countryside. Jockfall is situated 35 km north of Överkalix.

The magical setting, the river's roar and the unspoilt countryside are balm for body and soul. You get away from stressful, noisy environments to an oasis of tranquillity.

To many, Jockfall is a haven where they can find calm and relaxation, walking in the forest or simply sitting on a rock to watch the majestic falls. To others, it means fishing, and the hunt for that elusive great salmon.

The campground lies in a beautiful setting on the banks of the River Kalix, about 100 m from the fishing. There are a total of 36 beds in 4-bed cabins. There are showers and toilets in the service building, and a woodfired sauna nearby. The campground has a restaurant with a large veranda, where you can sit and enjoy your meal while listening to the thundering falls – an unbeatable experience. We also have an anglers' shop and a salmon ladder where you can see the salmon on their way up the river.



Activities

Apart from the excellent fishing at Jockfall, we offer a number of other activities;

- Fishing in the Torne River, above all at Tärendö with its famous bifurcation
- Walking on the scenic hiking trails
- Sauna raft: enjoy a relaxing sauna voyage on a calm or on the River Kalix, while enjoying a delicious dinner.
- Transport to one of our nearby foresters' cabins, where we prepare food and you can experience the old-time culture of the Jockfall area. You step back to the 30s and 40s and will be spellbound by the experience of the nature and culture of the past.
- Cooking in a grill hut, where we prepare and grill meat or salmon for you, which you then eat in or around the hut.
