



Summer in Swedish Lapland Mariebergs Viltfarm 🌿🌿🌿

Welcome to the Heart of Lapland, the area with two of Europe's last remaining undeveloped rivers, the Kalix and Torne river systems. For ten years, restoration has been going on after the logdriving era, which means that the area has 2,000 km of excellent angling waters and spawning grounds for game fish.

Our fisheries consultant Glenn Douglas from New Zealand chats and speaks to us about EU projects. Every winter in Jukkasjärvi, the Icehotel is built on the banks of the Torne River, then in spring it melts and 60 % of the melting ice flows into the River Kalix. The River Tärendö is a bifurcation – the only one in Europe - which connects the two rivers, Kalix and Torne. All seven tourist facilities lie on the biggest island in Sweden. Nature guiding looking at the Arctic Circle flora is provided by our Canadian nature expert.

Mariebergs Viltfarm 🌾🌾🌾

Mariebergs Viltfarm is an eco-farm located right on the beautiful, unspoiled Kalix River. You can choose to stay in a hotel room or one of our modern cabins with TV, shower and WC. The facility has a total of 70 beds. There is a large sauna and spa section with an open fireplace. Dishes served in the restaurant include our own delicacies, deer, boar, reindeer, moose, and local fish specialities. If you are planning a conference, we have several different conference facilities, seating from 8 to 80 people, and our own cinema. The entire facility has wireless Internet.

Out in the 104 ha game enclosure you can see deer and boars, and can get to know our tame reindeer Pricken. In the game enclosure, exciting off-road adventures with a difference await you, either in a tracked vehicle or on a snowmobile. The activity museum has about 50 functioning veteran vehicles and deals with local military history from the 1940s on. We also offer horse activities all year. You get to fell your own tree, and drag it away by horse in the traditional way. For longer snowmobile tours in winter, we offer a safari on the ice to Rånön sea fishing camp.

The closeness to the river also gives you an opportunity to fish for salmon, trout, grayling, and pike. In the summer you can rent a boat or a canoe for a complete nature experience. Welcome to cosy, scenic Mariebergs Viltfarm



Nature experience-Culture package

- Day 1 - A cultural experience, the War Years 1939-1945. The war in North Scandinavia from Narvik to Salla in Finland. The WW2 Alert Museum and the cannons at Viltfarmen provide a total experience of the Kalix Line, Europe's longest eastward-facing fortifications. Why not spend the night in the Rock Fortress, with cannons from the time of King Gustav V?
 - Transport drawn by two horses, in an offroad vehicle, or in tracked vehicles
 - Sleep in a bomb-proof shelter
 - Hearty breakfast of fried eggs and bacon prepared over an open fire
- Day 2 - Nature guiding in Linnaeus' footsteps through the unique Arctic Circle and Midnight Sun flora. It is possible to grow cucumbers and tomatoes at the Arctic Circle!
 - Accommodation and three-course dinner of natural ingredients from around Viltfarmen
 - Sauna and relaxation
- Day 3-4 - Fishing in the untouched River Kalix or lake fishing
- Day 5 - Excursion in trolling boat, 10 km out into the Gulf of Bothnia, to Rånön Island fishing village and the sea experience. Food provided by the water, e.g. Norrbotten caviar the Kalix way. Walk around the island, seeing archipelago plants and wildlife
- Day 6-7 - Free day
